Awards

The Judged Competition

The judged competition is conducted as a blind taste test. Each entry will be judged on a 10-point scale for taste, texture, appearance, and overall quality. Judges will gather two, one-quart samples at different times for the preliminary and final round. Scoring will be by accountants of the highest integrity. The judges scores will be totaled. The winner will be the entry with the highest points total. The decision of the judges is final. The winner will be awarded the "Brunswick Stewbilee 1st Place Trophy."

The People's Choice

The People's Choice winners (top 6) will be the teams with the greatest number of ticket stubs from bona fide ticket purchasers. The holder of the ticket may vote for any entrant of his or her choice, for

any reason. The decision of the people is final. The winner of this part of the competition will receive the coveted "Brunswick Stewbilee People's Choice Trophy."

Presentation Competition

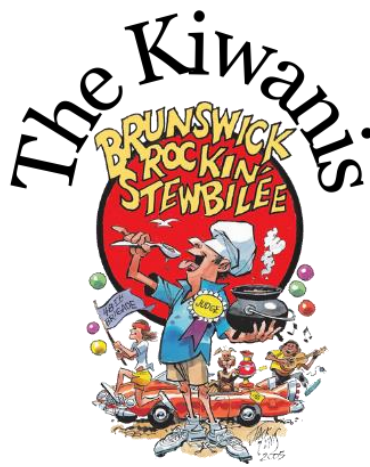
